Interior fittings :

6 berths

- Large owner's double cabin aft with bathroom (shower + dry toilet installed mid-2023) accessible from cabin or saloon
- Double cabin forward with bathroom accessible from the cabin, currently used as storage room
- U-shaped saloon to port that can be converted into a true saloon, spacious and comfortable, pleasant living space
- Well-equipped galley with all necessities overlooking the saloon
- Chart table and electrical panel to starboard
- Numerous lockers and storage space (closet + equipment)
- Sail locker at foot of companionway and large locker in cockpit

Construction

IDYLLE 13.50 polyester sailboat built in 1986 by the BENETEAU shipyard to plans by architect German Frers. The hull is in polyester resin with laminated counter mould, and the deck is made of balsa sandwich. The bulkheads are glued and laminated to the counter-mold and deck. The result is a solid, rigid whole.

The yacht arrived in French Polynesia in 1991 and has been sailing in its waters ever since.

The boat has passed through the hands of five owners.
