



Outremer 33 (10,27 m) - 2012



Layout :

- Length : 10,27 m (33' 8")
- Width: 3.20 m
- Draft: 1.65 m
- Material: thick aluminium (6 to 20mm)
- Rigging: Cutter
- Displacement (lightship, load): 6 tons empty, 7.8 tons max. according to the architect
- Engine: Yanmar 3JH40 40CV from 2022

Price : 12 M XPF / 100 600 euros

Thick weighted aluminium centerboard.

Interior fittings :

6 berths

- Anchor locker accessible from inside only
- Bow station with large double berth, windlass batteries and water tank
- Large, bright saloon with galley to port
- To starboard, bench seat serving as watch berth
- Large old-fashioned chart table to port
- Starboard marine toilet + gigantic hold up to the transom, occupying the entire aft end of the boat, accessible only toilets
- On the port side, a double berth is currently being used as a workshop.

Construction and history

Strongal aluminum boat: 10mm bottom, bulkhead, deck, deckhouse in 8mm, cockpit in 6mm, keel in 20mm by the Meta shipyard in Tarare, based on Michel Joubert's plans.

The first owner bought the hull bare and took around 12 years to complete the woodwork. Following a stroke shortly after launching in 2012, he was forced to cancel his sailing plans. The boat was then kept dry at Grau du Roi, which prevented it from deteriorating.

The current owner is a professional skipper and former shipyard manager, who has spent most of his career in the boating industry. He bought the boat in 2018 and completed the equipment according to modern standards and his extensive sailing experience.

An anti-slip thermal and acoustic insulation was installed (5mm Seacork panels). All the electrics have been redone, with only a few original cables remaining. The electronics have been installed, the plumbing redone, and the safety system overhauled, with the installation of hard railings, a mast balcony, a handrail overhanging the cockpit, and lifelines.

Maintenance or major work (years) :

2018: deck covering, adaptation of fittings for single-handed sailing

2019: electricity and plumbing, ultrasonic antifouling system, AIS and Axiom

2020: installation of autopilot with hydraulic jack, radar

2022: diesel engine, S-drive, propeller, service and windlass batteries

2023: fridge, new set of sails (1 mainsail in reserve), bimini, Bidata instruments

2024: new lazy-bag, new dinghy, liferaft overhaul, windlass repair, anchor chain changed
